


Use the downloadable Snack Pals snowflake cutout for easy-peasy snowflake making.

Grab a grownup to help cut out the square to the right. Fold the square diagonally in half along the line to create a triangle. Fold in half once more to get a smaller triangle. Fold the left section toward the back, then fold the right section toward the back. With the help of an adult, cut away the shaded area. Unfold the paper to reveal your beautiful





Try it outside! Once you make your snowflake, tape it to a window. Then grab a parent and a magnifying glass (or a parent's smart phone) and head outside. Look closely at the snowflakes outside. How do they compare to your paper snowflake?
