clouds you can identify!





How to Make Your Cloud Finder:

- 1. **Cut It Out:** Carefully cut along the lines to remove the Cloud Finder from this page.
- 2. Cut Out Inner Box: Cut out inner box along the dashed lines.
- **3. Stick It On:** Glue or tape a large popsicle stick to the back of the Cloud Finder.
- **4. Cloud Hunt:** Go outside and use your Cloud Finder to spot and name different clouds! Try to find one of each type if the weather allows.
